Applications are invited from enthusiastic and motivated individuals to join the dynamic radiotherapy physics team at the North West Cancer Centre. Duties will include providing general clinical scientific support across all areas of the radiotherapy service, including treatment planning, imaging and radiation dosimetry. Applicants must be state registered clinical scientists or eligible for registration within 12 months.

The Cancer Centre, which includes a new state of the art radiotherapy department, opened in November 2016 to enable a population of approximately 500,000 people in the West of Northern Ireland and Co Donegal, Republic of Ireland to avail of radiotherapy services closer to home. An integrated multi-disciplinary management structure ensures all healthcare professionals can contribute to maintaining an advanced and agile clinical service.

The service is equipped with 3 Varian TrueBeam Slim linear accelerators, a 64 slice Siemens SOMATOM Definition AS Open CT scanner and there is direct access to MRI. Superficial treatments will be performed by an XStrahl 150 unit and the mould room is equipped with 3D printing technology.

Academic and development opportunities exist and all members of staff will benefit from a personally tailored development programme. These posts are eligible for a relocation package and flexible working will be considered.

Altnagelvin Hospital is only minutes from the city of Londonderry. There is access to high quality and affordable housing with many outstanding schools and educational institutions nearby. Derry is one of the most frequently visited cities in the UK with easy transport links to Belfast, Donegal, GB and mainland Europe.
