Dosimetry Audit in Radiation Oncology – where to next?

Short description of the workshop:

This workshop will follow on from a smaller workshop which was held at the ESTRO office in January. This smaller workshop reviewed the current status of dosimetry audit and proposed a task force to take forward the work which ESTRO can do to support this field, however there was not sufficient time to survey and discuss the needs of the community for greater implementation and development of dosimetry audit.

Preliminary program - list of topics to be covered:

- Current dosimetry audit being carried out (in addition to the Brussels meeting) – invited speakers and proffered papers
- Issues faced and what is needed for equitable access to dosimetry audit in Europe
- Presentation and discuss of results of a Europe wide survey on dosimetry audit (in collaboration with IAEA).

Expected outcome:

A roadmap for ESTRO support for dosimetry audit in Europe. Possibly including good practice and recommendation guidelines, a position paper and training courses (maybe online as well as face to face).

Target group:

National audit groups, national measurement institutions (standards labs), clinical trial audit groups, IAEA, those considering setting up audit groups.
